This Tuesday brings the new live-album experience from Oasis entitled Familiar To Millions. The Epic Records release will be available in two-CD, VHS video, or DVD format and was recorded at Wembley Stadium over two days this past July. Sprinkled among their hits are covers of Neil Young's "Hey Hey, My My" and The Beatles' "Helter Skelter." ... He was only seven years old when he saw a rerun of the 1965 holiday television classic A Charlie Brown Christmas, but it served as one of his earliest introductions to jazz. Next week the Atlantic Records label releases jazz pianist Cyrus Chestnut's remake of the Vince Guaraldi soundtrack with vocals by Vanessa Williams, Brian McKnight, and the Boys Choir of Harlem. Before his recent death, Peanuts creator Charles Schulz endorsed the project while in production. ... Formed 13 years ago as a side project of Front Line Assembly founder Bill Leeb, Delerium continues to thrill fans of its lush ambient soundscapes. Next Tuesday brings a new album, Poem, with guest vocals by Sixpence None the Richer's Leigh Nash, Matthew Sweet, Kirsty Hawkshaw of Opus 3, and the Medieval Babes. Look for a limited-edition Digipak containing a bonus disc of mixes and unreleased tracks. ... Boy-eee! It's time to bust out the cardboard from yer Mom's new fridge as the modern-day B-boy and B-girl have much to get poppin' and breakin' this week. Epic Records issues the first of its Vinyl Exams – a new classic-hip-hop series hosted by DJ Bobbito in the mix-show format. Interviews with pioneers like Afrika Bambaataa and the Fat Boy's Prince Markie Dee are blended into the set alongside music from Schooly D, the Treacherous 3, Run-D.M.C., the Fearless 4, Roxanne Shante, Biz Markie, and more. The enhanced portion of the CD includes multimedia elements of hip-hop culture with Grand Wizard Theodore and the Rock Steady Crew's Crazy Legs. ... And on a funkier note, Hip-O Records salutes 30 years of undeniable groove with its 55-track, four-CD Funk Box this week. All the greats are represented – James Brown, Rick James, Kool & the Gang, Curtis Mayfield, Parliament/Funkadelic, the Brothers Johnson, War, the Gap Band, Cameo, Commodores, Average White Band, and more. A 48-page booklet chronicles the story of funk with the hair, the styles, and historical anecdotes.
