Friday, September 24, 11:30-ish: I attend a morning screening of **You Again**, and pretty much know what I'm in for as soon as the Touchstone Pictures logo appears: a brightly lit, jauntily scored, aggressively manic entertainment with plenty of "heart" and no laughs whatsoever. (I half-expect a Tim Allen cameo, but instead get a Dwayne Johnson cameo, which probably should've been

expected.)

It turns out I'm wrong. There actually *are* a few laughs, courtesy of Sigourney Weaver, doing a witty riff on her *Working Girl* monster, and Kyle Bornheimer, delivering a rehearsal-dinner toast that's simultaneously poignant, pathetic, scary, and hysterical. The rest of director Andy Fickman's comedy of warring (former) high-school rivals is a broad farce lacking in energy and invention; the slapstick ranges from tired to embarrassing; and most of the performers – including Kristin Bell, Jamie Lee Curtis, Victor Garber, Kristin Chenoweth, and Betty White (who should

really
give it a rest already) – simply go through the motions. I am, however, caught off-guard by the scene that finds Weaver and Curtis waging war in a swimming pool. With the stars of
