Secretary Announces Electric System Improvements in Eight States

More than \$11 million in Smart Grid Improvements Included

NORFOLK, Va., Sept. 5, 2013 – Agriculture Secretary Tom Vilsack today announced funding for projects in eight states to improve electric systems and provide more reliable service to rural residents.

"These investments will continue to ensure safe, reliable and affordable service for rural residents, farmers and businesses," Vilsack said.

For example, the Central Virginia Electric Cooperative will use USDA funding to build 327 miles of line and 10 substations in Virginia.

Iowa

- Midland Power Cooperative – \$25,300,000. Funds will be used to serve 530 customers, build 552 miles of line and 10 substations.

Kansas

- Lane-Scott Electric Cooperative, Inc. – \$28,460,000. USDA funds will be used to serve 580 customers, build 552 miles of line and 10 substations.
- Bluestem Electric Cooperative, Inc. – \$12,850,000. Funds will be used to serve 431 customers, build 552 miles of line and 10 substations.

Missouri and Iowa

- United Electric Cooperative, Inc. – \$26,625,000. Funds will be used to serve 652 customers, build 552 miles of line and 10 substations.
