Little Miss Sunshine

. Battles is an electro-psychedelic-progressive-rock "super group" that combines Stanier's quick and solid beats with trippy guitars and synthesizers, and features accomplished guitarists/keyboardists Ian Williams, Dave Konopka, and Tyondai Braxton. After leaving Helmet, one of my favorite noise-metal bands, in 1998 - and for those who'd argue, yes, they were

metal - Stanier resurfaced in 2000, joining ex-Faith No More singer Mike Patton's group Tomahawk. (In 2002, Tomahawk opened for Tool at the Mark of the Quad Cities.) Stanier formed Battles in 2003, and the band's

is its first full-length album and its first release to feature actual vocals, and according to a *Rolling Stone*
