Groundbreaking Ceremony Scheduled for Friday, April 12 at 1:45 p.m.

Galesburg, IL – The third project in the Galesburg Community Unit School District (CUSD) #205 \$110M Master Facility Plan, Operation Rebuild Achievement, is ready to kick off. At 1:45 p.m. on Friday, April 12th a groundbreaking ceremony will be held to commemorate the beginning of construction on the Galesburg High School at 1135 W. Fremont Street in Galesburg, IL. Press is invited to attend.

The Galesburg High School will undergo multiple renovations over the next few years. Phase one of the project will commence this spring and include the construction of a 50,514 s.f. multipurpose building, 2,840 seat stadium, two new softball fields, renovations to the existing varsity baseball field, remodeling of the existing strength training room into a wrestling room, and overall site improvements. Future phases of work to the facility include lobby and security remodeling, roofing, and renovations to the existing High School and Wicall gymnasium.

“The overall building Master Facility Plan is an integral part of our district’s mission of Helping Students Achieve Their Dreams. We are excited to offer upgraded facilities to improve our footprint on the ecosystem by installing geothermal heating and cooling systems. The opportunity to upgrade our technology to help our students meet the demands of the 21st century global economy is one of the primary objectives of Galesburg High School project,” stated Bart Arthur, Superintendent of Schools at Galesburg CUSD #205.

In March 2011, Galesburg CUSD selected Russell Construction and Dewberry Architects to deliver the 10-year / \$110M Master Planning process designed to improve student achievement and increase property values by investing in the revitalization of 11 buildings within the district.
