Thomson Prison would add 1,100 local jobs to region & alleviate national prison overcrowding

WASHINGTON, D.C. - Today, Congressman Dave Loeb sack (IA-02) and Congresswoman Cheri Bustos (IL-17) urged the House Appropriations Committee to provide funding for the activation of Thomson Prison in their appropriations bill for Fiscal Year 2014.

In a letter to the Chairman of the Appropriations Subcommittee on Commerce, Justice, Science, and Related Agencies (CJS), Congressman Frank Wolf of Virginia, and the Ranking Member, Congressman Chaka Fattah of Pennsylvania, Loeb sack and Bustos urged the inclusion of the Department of Justice's budget request to activate new prisons, including Thomson prison.

Loeb sack has long pushed to activate funding for opening Thomson Prison. He has worked to push Chairman Wolf to include this funding in previous appropriations bills.
