After 11 years of studying Deer/Vehicle Collisions, State Farm is noticing a decline in the number of crashes nationally. This trend is happening in Illinois as well. According to State Farm Claim Data, the likelihood of a collision with a deer has declined 10% across the state moving Illinois from 30<sup>th</sup> to 32<sup>nd</sup> place. That means drivers now have a 1 in 214 chance to hit a deer compared to last year's 1 in 162. In Iowa, crashes went up slightly moving that state from 4<sup>th</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> place.
