What the Dickens? Charles in Charge @ Frieze

From Great Expectations to A Christmas Carol, the novels of Charles Dickens still captivate readers. This year's Frieze Lecture series celebrates the bicentennial of the author's birth with four lectures by Augustana College professors. The lectures, and the coffee and cookies afterwards, are free and open to the public.

2:00 pm, Tuesday, Oct. 23: Dr. Karin Youngberg will provide an overview of the life and work of Charles Dickens. Dr. Youngberg will set the table for Dickens' place in literature and history. **2:00 pm, Tuesday, Oct. 30: Dr. David Ellis** will speak on the world of Dickens, considering key themes and issues in British, European and global history. **2:00 pm, Tuesday, Nov. 6: Dr. Catherine Goebel** will offer a slide lecture on artists important to Dickens. Dr. Goebel will discuss both those artists who were favorites of Dickens and those who found inspiration in his literary works. **2:00 pm, Tuesday, Nov. 13: Dr. Umme al-Wazedi** will provide a post-colonial view of the pro-colonial Dickens, and consider how his place in literature has changed in a world vastly different from the one in which he lived.
